Your mastery of English should be consistent with Club standards. That is, you **speak** English fluently and grammatically and **understand** spoken English with a high degree of comprehension. This is vital because the success of the Toastmasters learning process depends on your giving speeches and **understanding** and **absorbing** the feedback you receive from your evaluators and mentor. Since you will be called on to **evaluate** other members' speeches and grammar, you will combine your ability to understand what was said with your ability to provide **clear** and **articulate** feedback.

If the above requirements are met, you will receive an invitation from VP Membership to present your candidacy to the club by giving a short talk (not more than 3 minutes) from the lectern, telling us:

- Why you would like to join
- What the club can bring to you
- What you can bring to the club

After you have spoken, you will be escorted out of the room, and the club will vote on your candidacy, as required by Toastmasters International rules. You will then be escorted back into the room. If you are voted into the club, you will be asked to pay the applicable membership dues that night. This can be done by check or cash.
